

General instructions

Hello,

As part of the registration process for studies, you are being asked to undergo an examination process.

The course of tests that you will take includes exams of different types, which test your skills and characteristics, which are relevant to the course of studies for which you are a candidate.

- The length of the tests is about three hours.
- The tests are computerized, and there absolutely no need for prior experience in operating a computer, in order to succeed.
- For every question in the test, a number of possible answers will be shown. You must choose the answer that is the most correct.
- Every test opens with a section of explanations and sample questions. Read and study closely the instructions before taking any action
- In the test you cannot use a calculator. You will be given scratch paper for your calculations.
- Note, you can take a repeat exam (also for another study institution), only three months after the former exam, but no more than three exams during a period of 13 months.
- Foreign languages: you may be tested in English, Russian, Arabic, French and Spanish. Those interested must inform the college, or TIL International when registering for the exam.
- Customized tests: Students with learning disabilities are asked to enter a TIL site to tab> Information for candidates or from the following link http://www.tilint.co.il/examinees-info The site provides a detailed explanation of the documents required for the purpose of receiving test adjustments. The documents must be sent by e-mail til.office@tilint.com or fax 1533-6158-701
- Candidates wishing to be tested in TIL's office- You have a system for scheduling an examination. The entrance to the system is carried out from a TIL's web site from the top bar of the site, under tab> Information for candidates. You can get directly from the link http://www.tilint.co.il/examinees-info At the end of the coordination, an email will be sent containing the date chosen and all the relevant information for the examination.
- Payment for the exam can be done at the wire site under tab> Information for candidates or Through the link http://www.tilint.co.il/payment.html You must select from the list of educational institutions the appropriate institution. You must take the exam with a printed payment certificate and an ID. The validity of the approval is up to one month from the date of issue.
- Here are some sample questions. These questions represent different fields which are included in the exam, but they do not represent all the types of question that appear in the test, or the level of difficulty of all the questions.
